- master's degree in Polish or Slavic philology, master's thesis focused on linguistics;
- active participation in the scientific community, particularly publications, conference papers, research trips;
- experience in researching personal and geographical names, taking into account interdisciplinary approaches and issues related to historical source studies and archival studies;
- knowledge of computer programmes and tools used in onomastic projects;
- plans for individual scientific research within the scope of the Department of Onomastics, IPL PAS scientific profile.

- teamwork skills;
- fluency in English language.

**Scope of responsibilities:**

- on-site work at the Department of Onomastics at the Institute of Polish Language PAS in Kraków;
- work on entries for the *Nazwy miejscowe Polski. Historia – pochodzenie – zmiany* dictionary of Polish place names as per instructions and work schedule determined by the Department's head;

- participation in team projects at the Department of Onomastics;
- individual scientific research within the scope of the Department's scientific profile.

The candidate is required to present written consent for the Institute of Polish Language PAS to include them in the number of employed researchers in the discipline in question, as per *Prawo o szkolnictwie wyższym i nauce (art. 265 ust. 5) law*.
